SELECTING A NEW ADVISER

A student's initial college adviser may be a faculty <u>or</u> staff member. If, however, a student opts for a new adviser, that new adviser must be a <u>faculty member</u>.

Students may change advisers at most once per term (unless by permission of their residential college dean).

Most college deans will accept an email from the new adviser indicating willingness to serve in lieu of the new adviser's signature on this form.

Make sure to inform your current adviser, in person or by email, that you have selected a new adviser, and thank your current adviser for their service.
